

## **January 2003 : Turnover (VAT) + 12,2%**

In January 2003, compared to January of the previous year, Belgium's gross turnover of agriculture, industry and services (based upon VAT declarations) rose by 12,2%.

Turnover of industry and construction increased by 4,0%, while trade and services show an increase of 15,7%.

At the regional level, there was an increase by 11,2% in Flanders; in Wallonia turnover rose by 12,1% and in Brussels it went up by 14,1%.

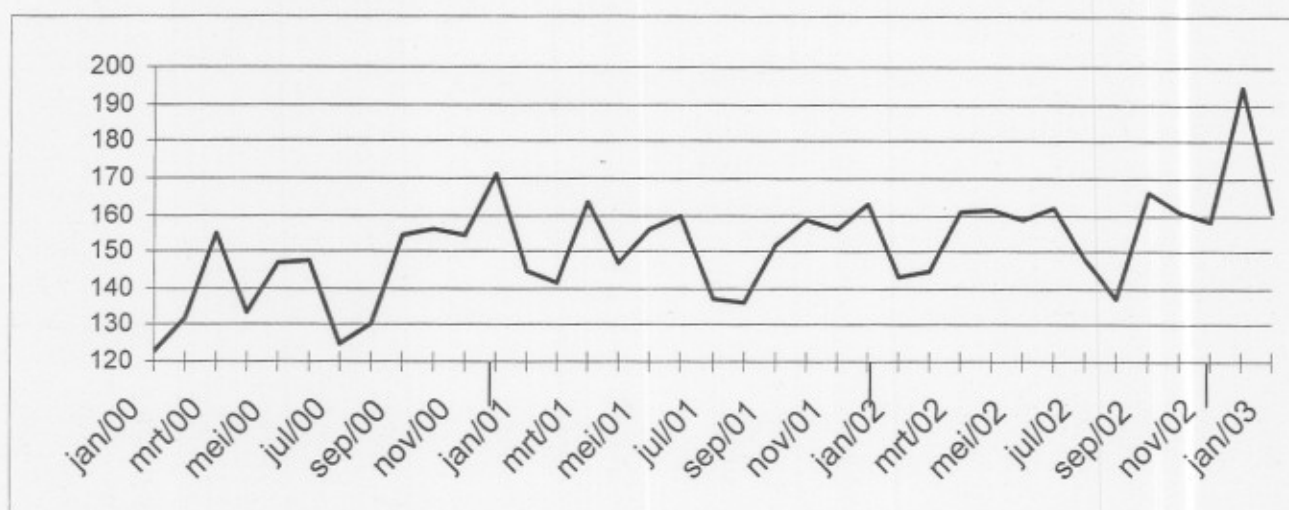

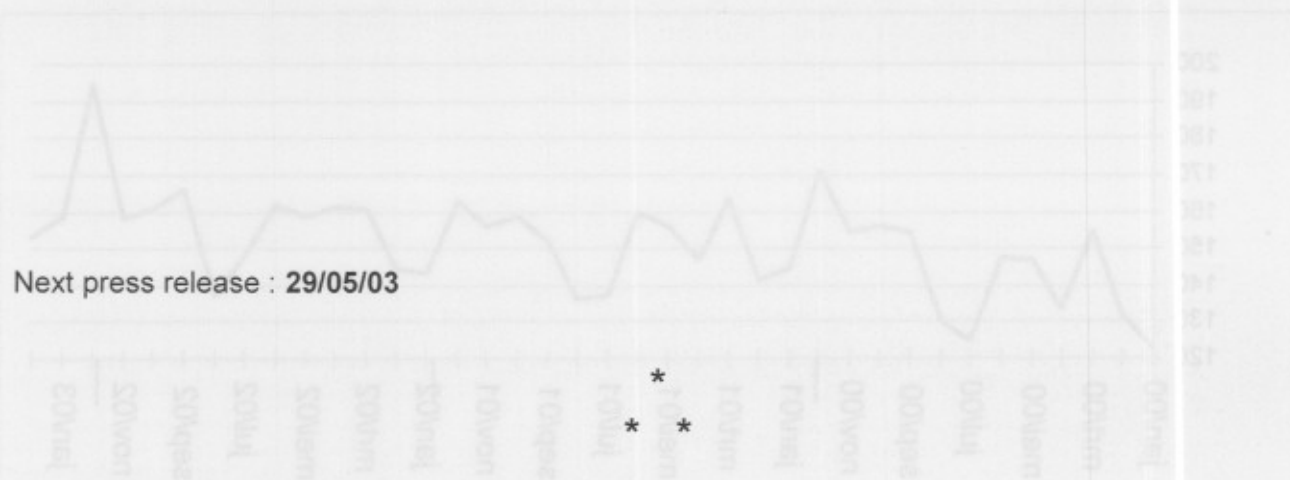

At the regional level, there was an increase by 10.2% in Flanders; in Wallonia turnover rose by 4.8% and in Brussels it went down by 6.5%.



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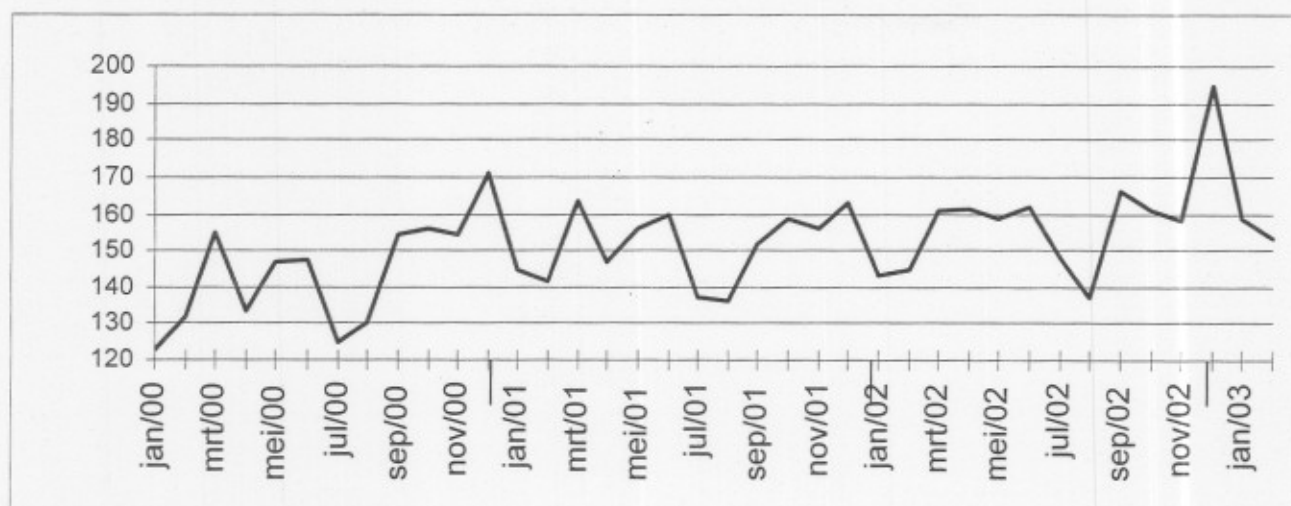

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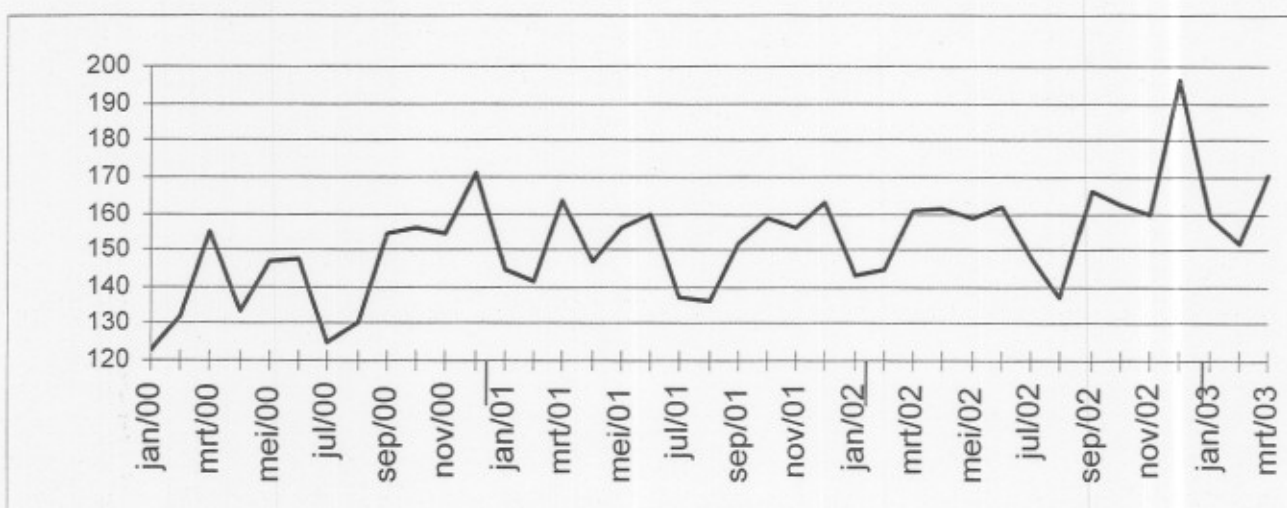
